Meet three new OKIM missionaries approved by the Oklahoma State Mission Board to receive OKIM funding in 2024

We are asking that you not only pray for these missionaries, but Oklahoma will stand with them financially so that they can represent Jesus and Oklahoma FWB in the proclamation of the gospel leading to making disciples and planting churches. All three of these couples are available to come to your church to share their stories and enter into partnerships with your churches.

#### JONATHAN & MICHELLE CHEREAU - FRANCE

We are currently serving at Saint Sebastien Church as leaders. First, I will be ordained in France as the first French free-will Baptist pastor.

We launched our ministry, Connexion Kidz. We organize every Wednesday afternoon for kids to learn English. We have 12 kids; many of them are not Christians, so it is a first approach to people and being able to invite them after to other events such as Christmas parties, Easter, the 4th of July, and Jpense events. We pray this ministry will expand and launch other events, like one for youth and college students and another for adults.

We will be helping with Jpense's service along with Joel and Lydie Teague.

Helping to plant new churches: right now, we have 4 FWB churches, but we would like to help plant new churches.

We also want to continue to grow as a denomination in France, helping translate books, training leaders, and helping with the project of a Bible institute in the future. Helping to develop our

IM team in France, getting closer working as a team, and recruiting new members.

We are praying that God will show us more opportunities and ideas to expand in France. For our church to grow in number while also being a strong testimony around our city, we will continue to train leaders for the church.

Tristen and Sierra White, Free Will Baptist International Missionaries to Tokyo, Japan. Tristen was born and raised in Gastonia, North Carolina. He received a degree in Ministry and Intercultural Studies from Randall University in May 2023. Sierra grew up in Owasso, Oklahoma, and received a degree in elementary education. She is

Less than 1% (0.37%) of the 127 million Japanese people have a relationship with Jesus making Japan the second largest unreached people group on the planet. FWB International Missions church planting effort in Tokyo)






